

Notice of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations 2019

Notice is hereby given that Malvern Hills District Council is conducting a review of the polling districts, polling places and polling stations within Malvern Hills District in accordance with Section 17 of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013. The purpose of the review is to ensure that the council provides reasonable facilities for voting and that polling stations are accessible to all electors.

The (Acting) Returning Officer for the Parliamentary Constituency of West Worcestershire will comment on the proposals. These representations will be published on the Council's website in accordance with the timetable set out below.

Electors within Malvern Hills may make a representation, which will also be made public as part of the final report. The Council would welcome the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, or any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability, on the proposals. Persons making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places. **The deadline for the receipt of comments is Friday 19th July.**
